

How to Screen Mirroring Your Devices

For iOS devices:

Method A: Wireless Connection with WiFi

1. Turn on the projector, go to "Screen Mirroring" and select "iOS Screen" or "Setting" to connect to your router's WiFi.
2. Turn on your iOS device's WiFi and connect to the same WiFi as above.
3. Go to "Screen Mirroring" on your phone and select "XX-XXXXX" of the projector to connect.

Method B: Wireless Connection without WiFi

1. Turn on the projector, select "Screen Mirroring", then select "iOS Screen".
2. Turn on your iOS device's WiFi, join the network "XX-XXXXX", pwd is 12345678
3. Go to the "Screen Mirroring" of your iOS device, then select "XX-XXXXX".

Method C: Wired Connection

1. Please prepare an official Apple Lightning to USB Cable, and enter the "Screen Mirroring" < "iOS Screen".
2. Plug the Cable into to USB port, click "Trust" on your iPhone the wired connection success.

For Android devices:

Method A: Wireless Connection with WiFi

1. Please check if your Android phone has a "Screen Casting" function in the settings first.
2. Turn on the projector, go to "Screen Mirroring" and select "Android Screen" or "Setting" to connect to your router's WiFi.
3. Turn on your Android device's WiFi and connect to the same WiFi as above.
4. Go on "Screen Casting" in your phone's settings and select "XX-XXXXX" to connect.

Method B: Wireless Connection without WiFi

1. Turn on the projector, select "Screen Mirroring", then select "Android Screen"
2. Turn on the WLAN and Bluetooth of your Android devices, no need to join network.
3. Go on "Screen Casting" in your phone's settings and select "XX-XXXXX" to connect.

How to Connect to Bluetooth Speakers

1. Go to the HOME main menu and select "Bluetooth".
2. Press "◀▶" to turn on the Bluetooth function, select "Search" and press "OK" to search for Bluetooth audio devices.
3. Select your Bluetooth audio devices, then press the "OK" button to pair.
4. When the projector is turned on or Bluetooth is turned on, the projector will try to connect to the last connected Bluetooth speaker. It is better to keep the Bluetooth speaker within 3m of the projector for stable transmission.

Tips:

1. The Bluetooth 5.1 function of the projector can be used as a Bluetooth transmitter to connect to a Bluetooth speaker/headset/earphone to enhance the sound when you need it. Not for phone data or video transmission.
2. If the projector's Bluetooth can't recognize your speaker, please try resetting the projector, turning your speaker off and then on again.

Warm Tips:

1. It is recommended to use the home theater projector in a dark environment, it will give the best effect.
2. The projector does not support Dolby Audio, please turn off Dolby Audio in the sound settings before playing the video.
3. The Bluetooth connection only supports connecting to an external speaker for louder sound. Not for phone data or video transmission.
4. Please make sure that the projector and your phone are connected to the same WiFi router, and keep the projector on the "Screen Mirroring for iOS/Android System" page before using your smartphone to project the screen.
5. Due to the HDCP copyright protection protocol, the projector does not support wireless video streaming from Netflix, Hulu, Amazon Prime, or Disney over the phone. Please project streaming video from your devices via a wired connection or an external streaming stick such as Fire TV Stick, Roku Stick, or Google Chromecast.

Trouble Shooting

Why can't I mirror/cast Netflix, Hulu, Amazon Prime, or Disney videos?

Due to the HDCP protocol, all projectors do not support streaming video from Netflix, Hulu, Amazon Prime, or Disney over the phone. However, you can connect a streaming stick such as Fire TV Stick, Roku Stick, or Google Chromecast to the projector via the HDMI port and enjoy millions of streaming videos from Netflix, Disney, Prime Video and more. You can also project streaming video from your devices via a wired connection.

Why is there no sound/image when I flip the video?

The projector does not support Dolby Audio, please turn off Dolby Audio in the sound settings before playing the video.

Due to the HDCP copyright protection protocol, the projector does not support wireless video streaming from Netflix, Hulu, Amazon Prime, or Disney over the phone. Please project streaming video from your devices via a wired connection or an external streaming stick such as Fire TV Stick, Roku Stick, or Google Chromecast.

Can I mirror or cast my smartphone via Bluetooth?

No, you can't. All projectors on the market do not support mirroring/casting via Bluetooth. The Bluetooth connection only supports connecting to an external Bluetooth speaker or soundbar for louder sound.

What should I do if there is a dark spot, shadow, or line in the projected image?

Try tapping the projector to see if the dust inside can be shaken off.

Clean the lens with a non-woven cloth.

Tear off the label on the bottom of the projector and open the bottom cover, then gently wipe the LCD inside the projector with a cotton swab or use a hair dryer to gently blow off the dust.

Why is my projector out of focus and blurry?

Please adjust the focus ring and keystone ring to try to optimize image quality.

Try adjusting the projection size according to the distance between the projector and the screen.

Why does nothing happen when I use the remote control?

The remote control does not come with batteries, so please prepare two AAA batteries and insert them into the remote control.

Point the remote control at the IR receiver on the front or rear of the projector.
