The standard portable MC-EX353E LCD has 3700 Ansi lumens, a contrast of 20000:1 and an XGA 1024 x 768 resolution. The manufacturer Maxell specifies a lamp life of 12500 hours, which is over 17.1 years with a daily viewing time of 2 hours. The horizontal and vertical keystone correction provides leeway when setting up. 3700 Ansi lumens ensure that a picture width of 530 cm is also possible. The projector creates rooms with residual light with a smaller image width, we recommend a maximum of 353 cm. The model is also Full HD 1080P compatible. The projector was launched in 2018 and is no longer sold by the manufacturer.



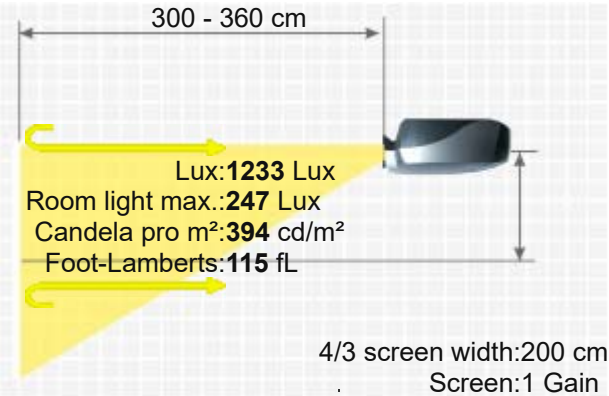

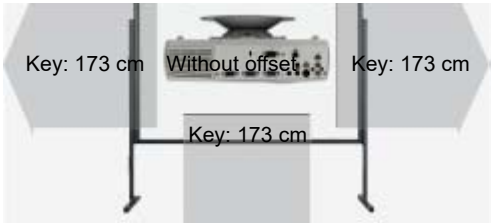
