The stationary PT L595E/U LCD projector from Panasonic has 600 Ansi lumens, a contrast of 200:1 and an SVGA 800 x 600 resolution. The projector can illuminate a picture width of up to 213 cm thanks to the 600 Ansi lumens. In room light, however, the image width should ideally be less than 142 cm. On the market since 1998, the model is no longer offered by the manufacturer Panasonic. Unfortunately, we can no longer offer replacement lamps for this model, neither originals nor replicas.

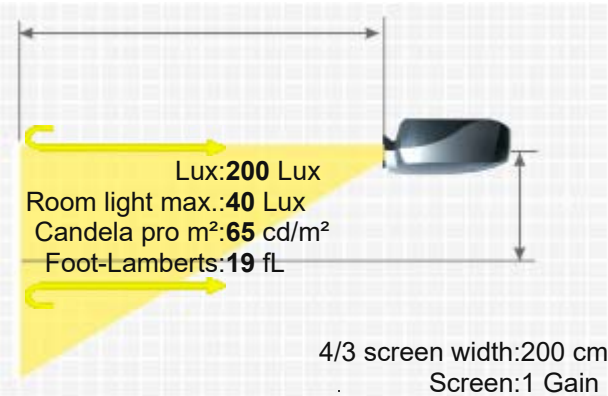
